

TOEIC Bridge® Speaking & Writing Tests Examinee Guide

Please read this examinee guide before check-in begins. This examinee guide will be collected by the staff after the test.

[Test Procedure]

*Confirm the location of the exit for emergencies.

Activity	Precautions			
Before Check-in	Prepare your "ID" and "Confidentiality Statement" documents beforehand. There is no break after check-in. Please use the restroom or take care of other needs.			
Cneck-in	[1] A valid photo ID proving your identity: Driver's License issued in Japan, Student ID issued in Japan, Passport, Individual number card, Basic resident register card, Certificate of Alien Registration, Resident's Card, Special permanent resident certificate, Driving record history certificate, Disability certificate(physical/mental) *If you do not have an ID, you will not be able to take the test. Have an ID with you at all times throughout the test administration. *Photocopies, photographs of the above will not be accepted. *If you have changed your name from the time of registration (due to any reason), inform the staff before check-in. The staff will explain the procedure. [2] Confidentiality Statement Read and confirm the contents of the Confidentiality Statement and fill out all the items referring to the example provided. If you don't agree with these terms, you will not be able to take the test.			
Check-in/ Start Test	 Have your ID, Confidentiality Statement and this examinee guide with you. If you have a cell phone, all the functions must be turned off. The staff will confirm at Check-in. *Items allowed to remain on the desk during the test will be this examinee guide, ID, Confidentiality Statement (backside memo column), and pen (provided by the test-center). Other belongings should be kept in your bag and placed under the table. * Use of watch is prohibited in the test room. After Check-in, the staff will guide you to your seat. When entering / leaving the room or taking a seat, do not pull on the headset cord and avoid contact with outlets or cables that may be under your feet. The test will not start for all candidates at the same time. You will start the test after you have taken your seat. 			
During Test	You are not allowed to leave the test room during the test. If you do not feel well, inform the staff by quietly raising your hand. (Extra testing time will not be allowed for absence.)			
After Test	Please leave the test room quietly, as the time of test completion is different for each examinee. Take any litter with you when you leave.			

[Attention]

Read the precautions written in the Confidentiality Statement and test screen (P.2 3). Failure to comply with the regulations may result in: Warnings from the staff, Your answers not being scored, Dismissal from the test site, Bag checks, Disqualification from taking any test which IIBC or ETS administers, Cancellation of any test scores administered by IIBC or ETS (including those previously awarded).

Test Result Notice

Your Official Score Certificate will be sent out within 35 days after the test. For details, refer to the TOEIC® Official Website.

Test Screen

Proceed following the process below. Raise your hand to inform the staff if you have any trouble with test equipment.

* For details, read the directions displayed on the screen. The staff will not be able to answer any questions about the contents of the test.

Check your Name, Birth date, and Address (address for Official Score Certificate)

If you want to correct Date of birth or Address

Log-in to the TOEIC® Application Site and change your registered information, within 10 days including the test day.

The test screen will display your prior information. The updated information will be printed on the Official Score Certificate.

If you want to change your registered name (due to any reason)

Refer to the TOEIC® Official Website, download and send the notification of changes to the IIBC Test Operation Center.

2 Click the check box

If the information displayed is correct, click the check box and proceed to the next page.

* You will not be able to proceed to the next page without clicking the check box.



3 After the TOEIC® Logo appears on the screen, check HELP and Confidentiality Agreement

Click [Continue] in the upper right corner.

Put on the headset

Make sure the microphone is located on the left side of your face, placed near your mouth. Do not touch the microphone while recording.



5 Changing the Volume

Click [Play] at the bottom of the screen and play sample instruction.

You will be able to change the volume with the [Volume]

If you cannot hear the instructions clearly, raise your hand to inform the staff. Do not click [Continue].



6 Recording test

1)Record your voice

Click [Rec] at the bottom of the screen and read the sample script. The content you speak will not be scored.

2)Confirm your recording

Click [Play] to confirm if your voice has been recorded correctly. If there is an error in the recording, the test may not be scored correctly.

If your recording is successful

Click [CONTINUE].

If there is any problem with the recording

Do not proceed to the next screen, raise your hand to inform the staff.

If you wish to record again

Proceed from 1).



7 TOEIC Bridge® Speaking Test Directions

TOEIC Bridge Speaking Test is approximately 15 minutes (8 questions). After checking the Speaking Test Directions, click [Continue]. *Remaining time will appear on the screen.



- Be careful not to touch the microphone or the cord with your hand. This may disrupt the recording process.
- If your voice is too loud, it may cause acoustic distortion and effect test scoring.

The end of the TOEIC Bridge® Speaking Test

TOEIC Bridge Writing Test will start automatically in 3 minutes. By clicking [Continue] in the upper right corner, you may start the test immediately.

<Wearing the headset during the TOEIC Bridge® Writing Test>

You may use the headset to reduce surrounding sounds during the test.



9 TOEIC Bridge® Writing Test Directions

TOEIC Bridge Writing Test is approximately 37 minutes (9 questions). After checking the Writing Test Directions, click [Continue].

*Remaining time for each question will appear on the screen.

Entire TOEIC Bridge Writing Test

■ Click [Help] Help to see how to answer the questions.

Click [Return] Return in the upper right corner to return to the question.

*The test will proceed while displaying the [Help] screen.



You cannot use shortcut keys, use the buttons on the screen as follows:


Cut	Highlight the text you want to cut and click [Cut].	Undo	Cancel your last action.
Paste	Click on the spot where you want to place the text and click [Paste].	Redo	Reverse the action of the [Undo] command.

■ To switch between uppercase and lowercase letters, press [Shift] key + [Caps Lock] key.

10 Check recorded audio for the TOEIC Bridge Speaking Test

Put on the headset and click [Play]. Listen to your answers to make sure they are recorded correctly. If there is any problem with the recording, please inform the staff. When you are finished, click [Submit] and move to the next page.



11 End of test

At the end of the test, raise your hand to inform the staff. Make sure to take all of your belongings with you. Please be quiet when leaving the test room.

*The staff will collect this examinee guide, the Confidentiality Statement, and pen after the test. Please be careful NOT to take any of these items with you.
